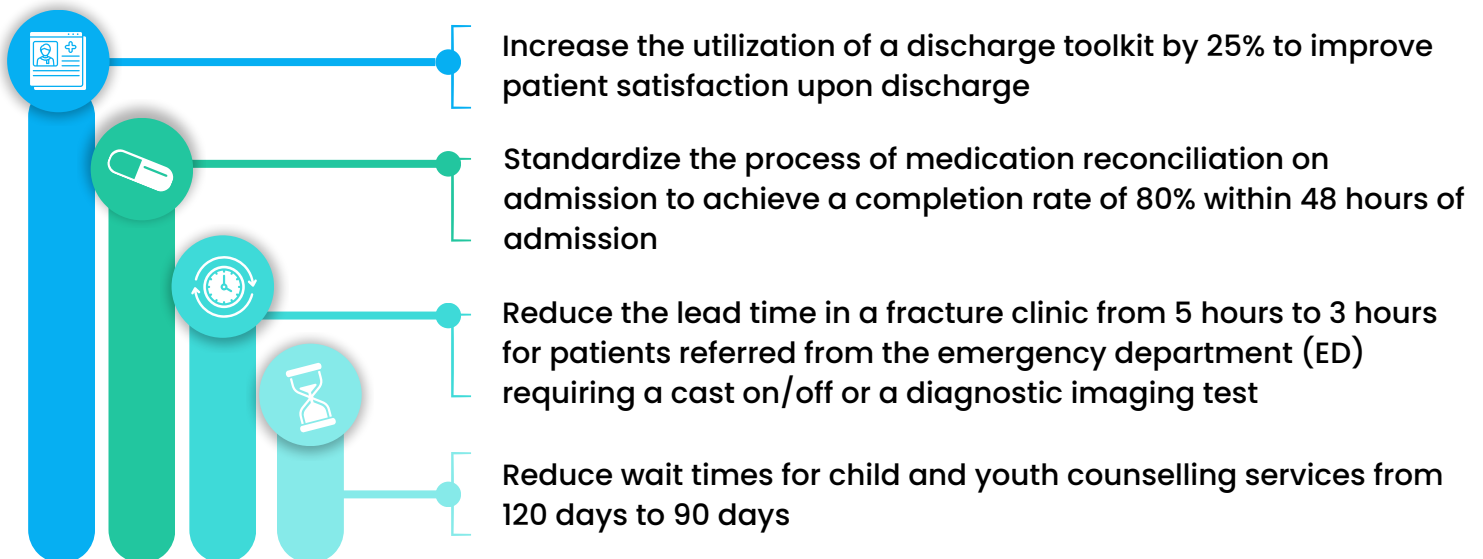
Assessment and Certification
